Executive Summary

Winrose International Campus is a **mission-driven, community-based holistic youth development institution** registered under the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission of Sri Lanka as a **Vocational** Training Center, located in the cool hills of Blackwood between Beragala and Haputale Sri Lanka.

Winrose was named after combining the names of two great social workers in Sri Lanka who had dedicated their whole lives in uplifting the education and social standards of the people in the hill country. Godwin R. Samuel, a veteran social worker and mission catalyst, and Adeline Rose Jothy Malar, a former principal, were the backbone and inspiration for establishing Winrose International Campus as the Hill Country's first standalone vocational training center that is driven solely by its mission and vision.

R.J. Sathya Reka Godwin, the founder/director of Winrose, founded the institute in 2007 with the goal of raising educational standards of the children in the hill country as her personal mission, who also happened to be one of the three offspring of Godwin and Rose.

Celebrating the 15th year of operations and proudly stepping towards the 16th, Winrose has **guided 1028 registered students by the end of 2021**.

Our primary goal is to encourage and train underprivileged tea plantation youths in Sri Lanka to pursue higher education and vocational training, by providing access to expensive professional and vocational training courses. as well as aiding and mentoring them in their quest for higher education.

Since 2016, we have helped hundreds students who have passed the G.C.E. advanced level with further education. As a result, many have secured reputable jobs in government and private organizations. We have produced remarkable results by using very minimal human and physical resources.

Background Information/Statement of the Problem:

The estate sector has been identified by the experts, as the most vulnerable community in Sri Lanka in terms of cultural, educational, financial, and social aspects. Identifying the various problems and discriminations faced by them, many national, international, private, and government sectors have implemented an immense number of development projects to uplift the living standards of plantation workers and their families. Even though the contributions of these organizations are noteworthy with success stories, there has always been a question about sustainability. Although considerable changes are seen in the community, the ultimate growth rate of the development is comparatively very low as priority is not given to developing the educational system. Although there are admirable methods that were adopted, the "trend-setting" approach is ignored compared with the other communities in Sri Lanka. A trend will be successful only if it is adopted and implemented by the majority of the community. People should influence each other. We create the originals that will be copied by others.

Presently, youths in the tea plantations are not interested in working in the tea plantations and are moving away from the estate sector towards the urban area to work in the shops, garment industries, construction industries, and many other manufacturing industries.

Discrimination and not getting social recognition are the underlying problems of their decision to move away from the tea plantation sector. However, the majority of the youths are not qualified to secure decent jobs, as they have studied up to OLs and are not prepared to work again in the plantation industry.

We identified that learning conversational English gives social recognition and self-confidence for these youths. Through boosting the language skills and personality development Winrose conduct the following courses.




Socio Economic Survey


The people of estate sector are undergoing very low level of living and severe poverty ridden condition. They are people who play crucial role in contributing to the foreign exchange earnings from total export. Because till today Sri Lankan economy depends upon estate sector to earn foreign exchange from primary commodities such as tea rubber and coconut which are produced by estate sector.


Winrose International Campus has completed a basic socio economic survey which will be expanded in future. The survey was mostly done online with the participation of 100 both advanced Level and ordinary level students from 13 plantation estates and villages who applied to follow vocational training courses and English at Winrose. The survey was done evidence based.

The survey has revealed and confirmed that the majority of the students are still facing poverty. Considering the economic hardship of the students especially during the pandemic Winrose has conducted all the classes totally free.









New Face in 2020/2021

Winrose has been running as a self-funded project since 2007 providing totally free services to the community. Witnessing the success of 11 years of untiring hard work Winrose had decided to move on to next step towards success and successfully registered as a vocational training center under the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission of Sri Lanka on the 26th February 2018.

Though the institute was recognized by the government the institute suffered because of lack of funds and resources.

Students Recruitment - 2020/2021

Winrose International Campus started its education services with a new dimension end of 2020. We have recruited 83 students in 2021. Every year, after the Ordinary level and advanced level

examinations we conduct several awareness programs for both the students and their parents. The students who are willing to join our institution are recruited and the students who prefer different study paths are given necessary information and guidance to follow their preference of study.

Parents are also made aware about the support and guidance that they have to provide to their kids. We encourage especially the fathers to participate in the awareness programmes.









Hospitality Management

Hospitality management was the first vocational qualification introduced in Winrose. The idea of starting the course was emerged when our own students graduated from the University College of Jaffna completing their higher national diploma in Hospitality management and BSc. In Hospitality management.

We recruited the lecturers who are qualified and experienced in hospitality field. We recruited 30 students at the end of 2020 in two batches and we were able to provide them the best learning experiences in hospitality field.

Initially we had to take the students to various hotels in this area for practical training. Introduced by Mr. R. Gnanasekaram, Mr. S. Kannan a philanthropist donated kitchen tools and equipment worth of Rs.700,000. The donation has facilitated the students to learn professional cookery.

Information and Communication Technology

ICT in education improves engagement and knowledge retention: When ICT is integrated into lessons, students become more engaged in their work. This is because technology provides different opportunities to make it more fun and enjoyable in terms of teaching the same things in different ways. As a consequence of this increased engagement, it is said that they will be able to retain knowledge more effectively and efficiently.

Students with low IQ are no longer at a disadvantage as they have access to essential material and special ICT tools can be used by students to make use of ICT for their own educational needs.

At Winrose we teach students "Information and Communication Technology" course which is accredited by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission of Sri Lanka, and also, we incorporate technology in the classes to enhance and facilitate the learning process.

To develop the ICT capabilities of the students we provide them with meaningful activities, embedded in purposeful subject-related contexts

Our Computer Lab consists of Ten computers.

Winrose IT Center enables the students to learn in a friendly, supportive, environment. It's a chance for beginners to learn the basics of computing but also get formal qualifications at the same time, and it's a great place to be a student as well.

Presently, we are equipped with ten computers donated by Dr.Devarani Anandasabapathy through IMHO, Manitha Neyam Trust and Vanni Hope Australia.

We offer computer application assistant course which is approved by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission of Sri Lanka. Our students are given extra coaching on typing skills in English, Tamil, and Sinhala.

Financial Accounting

Financial literacy is a core life skill for participating in modern society. Children are growing up in an increasingly complex world where they will eventually need to take charge of their own financial future.

National surveys show that young adults have amongst the lowest levels of financial literacy. This is reflected by their general inability to choose the right financial products and often a lack of interest in undertaking sound financial planning. For example, in the plantation sector most youths buy three wheelers when their parents get their provident funds. They tend to pay the first down payment but will struggle to pay the installments and will end up getting their three wheelers seized by the vehicle companies. It's also common in the plantation sector to get micro loans with higher interest rate.

Even from an early age, children need to develop the skills to help choose between different career and education options and manage any discretionary funds they may have, whether from allowances or part time jobs. These funds may entail the use of savings accounts or bank cards. Winrose aims to create more students who are financial literate.

Introducing New Course - AAT Course (Association of Accounting Technicians)

Anjana Thiyagaraja BBA (UG) (Operations Management. SPCL) University of Peradeniya Commenced AAT first level classes during April 2020 for students who are interested in



pursuing their career in accounting & financial field. This was the first class for Tamil medium students in this region. 10 students are enrolled in this course. And more students are being recruited.

The classes were initiated by Miss. Anjana Thiyagaraja who is an Undergraduate of University of Peradeniya also a product of Winrose

International Campus. She was the first inspiration to the students in Haputale region to enter university in commerce stream.


